'Little Tat' flew as a Spitfire fighter-bomber pilot with 4 Squadron, South African Air Force in Italy for nine months in 1944 and 1945. The four Spitfire Squadrons of 7 Wing, SAAF operated in a close support role to the British 8th Army ground forces by carrying out low-level dive-bombing and air to ground strafing attacks and also some strategical bomber escort missions. Tat survived 110 sorties against the Germans before VE day - which was six months before his 21st birthday.

This is an evocative story about actual, historically recorded, live action facts and incidents. There are *many* photographs plus four self-told accounts by Spitfire Pilots who had to bale out in Italy
